# A New Sports Hub



The Foundation's first project will be an exciting new Sports Hub. The Sports Hub is a major development project comprising a new Gymnasium, an Aquatic Centre and a state-of-the-art All-Weather Track at the southern end of the college.

The all-weather track will be a wonderful asset not just for the school but for the local Hutt community and the whole region, says Rector Gerard Tully.

"St Pat's is a strong and successful sporting college. Our goal is to have first-class amenities that can really benefit our students and the wider sporting community in the region. A strong partnership between school and community is the key to funding developments that would be out of reach for any one school or sporting code."



The Sports Hub will give the college a unique facility that will benefit generations of St Pat's students to come. The Sports

Hub project has already begun with designs for the gymnasium under way courtesy of seed funding from the Society of Mary. It is expected that the construction of the Gymnasium and the All-Weather Track will begin in September this year. Work on the aquatic centre will begin when fundraising targets are achieved.

The Sports Hub, together with the school's boarding and dining facilities, will provide the school with a first-class facility that can be used by community groups and organisations, generating valuable income for the college.

The Sports hub will be built in two stages. The first stage is the Gymnasium and All-Weather Track. The second stage will be the Aquatic Centre. 

**Fundraising Target for Foundation – the difference of \$2,500,000 (2012–2014).**
